

The Agenda of the next Ordinary Biesse Shareholders' Meeting integrated. Proposed a Buy-Back plan

Pesaro, 19 March 2020 – The Biesse Board of Directors, held today in an extraordinary mode, decided to integrate the Agenda of the next Ordinary Biesse Shareholders' Meeting (21 April 2020/8 May 2020) as follows:

- point nr.6: authorization to buy and dispose of treasury shares; inherent and consequent resolutions
